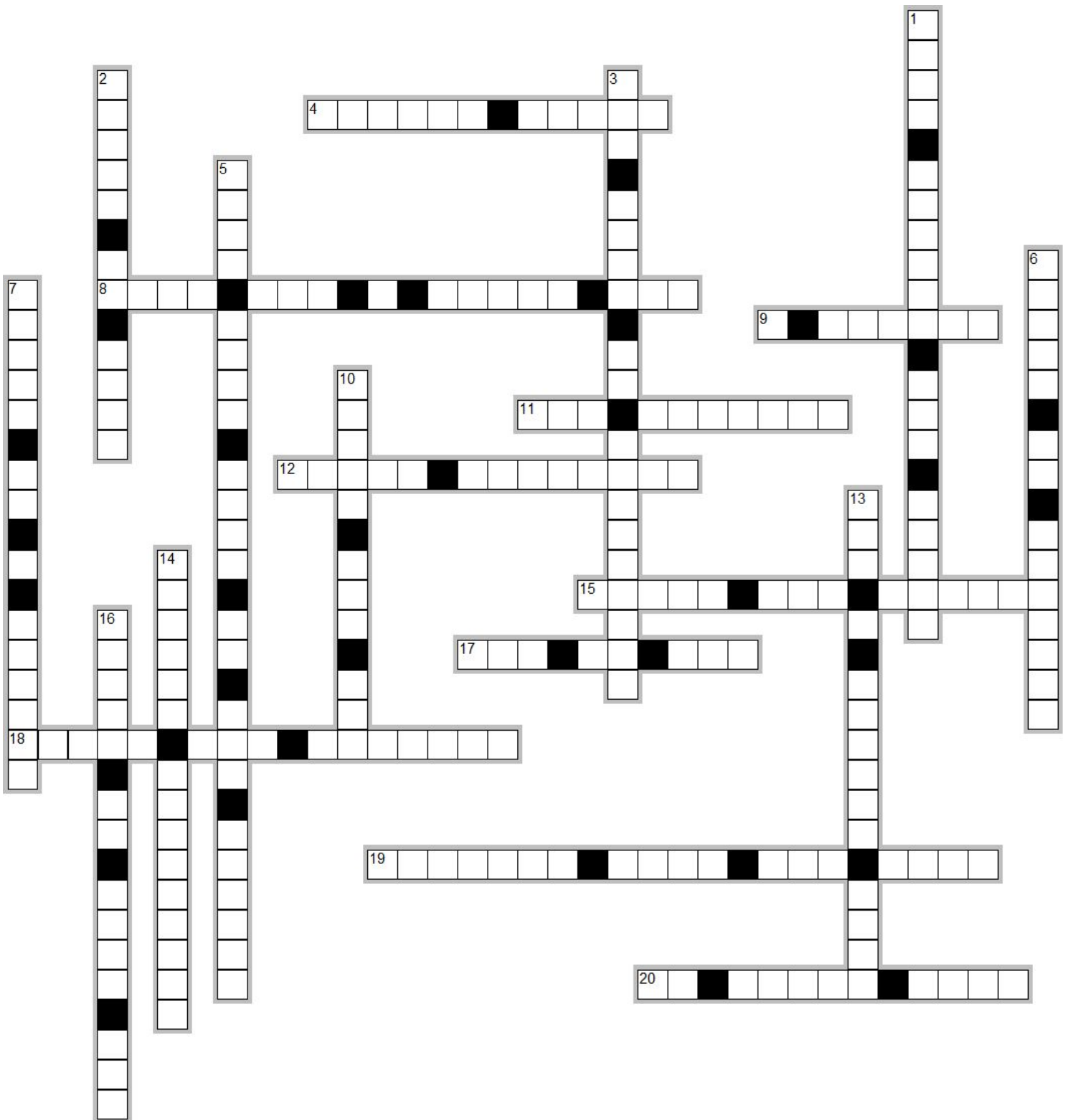


Weather Idioms Crossword
